The Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce that we have awarded the AAUW Harrisburg scholarships to three deserving young women. They embody the ideals of AAUW and the spirit, educational, and societal values of the ladies for whom the scholarships are named.

Katrina Smith is this year's recipient of the **Beverly J. Smith Memorial Scholarship**. Kat graduated from Lower Dauphin High School and attended Harrisburg Area Community College for two years. She is now at Slippery Rock University, majoring in Early Childhood Education, Special Education, and International Education. On campus, Kat is a member of the Kappa Delta Pi Honor Society, National Council for Teacher Education, and the Internations Club.

Katherine Migatulski was the committee's choice for the **Mary Lou McDowell Memorial Scholarship**. Katherine is from Boiling Springs and has completed two years of coursework at Harrisburg Area Community College.
