- () New member "buddy" – Help a new member "navigate," feel welcomed, and engage by attending branch activities together, connecting her to others, and sharing your knowledge and experience.
- () Programs - Volunteers are needed to bring refreshments to certain meetings.
- () Scholarship - Volunteers on the Scholarship Committee review and update materials each year and assist in the dissemination of information to the public. They review applications submitted and select the student recipients for each scholarship.
