Day 1: Thursday, April 27, 2023 Overnight Flight Explore Croatia and the countries of the Adriatic, a region filled with ancient cities, medieval architecture, intriguing cultures, rolling hills and stunning coastal scenery.

Day 2: Friday, April 28, 2023 Dubrovnik, Croatia - Tour Begins Your tour begins in the medieval city of Dubrovnik. Get to know your fellow travelers during a welcome dinner this evening. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, April 29, 2023 Dubrovnik Join a local guide on a tour of the “Old Dubrovnik,” a UNESCO World Heritage site. This evening, travel to Cilipi in the culturally rich Konavle region, where you’ll be welcomed for dinner at a family-owned restaurant. Visit with the family and learn about life in the Croatian heartland as you sample regional wines. At dinner, servers introduce you to a culinary feast, prepared in the way of their ancestors. Day 4: Sunday, April 30, 2023 Dubrovnik Spend today at leisure. Relax or independently explore the marble streets and beautiful baroque buildings of Dubrovnik’s breathtaking Old Town. Or, perhaps you’ll embark on an optional culinary excursion where you will journey along the Pelješac Peninsula and sample local wines paired with fresh oysters plucked from the sea. (B)

Day 5: Monday, May 1, 2023 Dubrovnik - Split Savor stunning sea views as you travel up the winding coastal road, hugging the sheer cliffs that drop dramatically into the aquamarine of the Adriatic Sea. Enjoy a stop in a quaint village in the Croatian countryside. You will have time to taste some of the local specialties and perhaps take a walk through the village square. Upon arrival in Split, set out on a walking tour featuring the impressive Diocletian's Palace (UNESCO), one of the most significant late-Roman historical monuments, and also see the peristyle of the palace and the Temple of Jupiter. Day 6: Tuesday, May 2, 2023 Split - Plitvice Lakes Enjoy a relaxing morning at leisure. You might consider an optional trip to Trogir, a city of medieval walls, towering cathedrals, and captivating Venetian architecture. This afternoon, travel to Plitvice Lakes, one of the oldest, largest, and most beautiful national parks in Croatia. Inspiring scenery is one of the wonders you’ll experience at this designated UNESCO World Heritage site. (B, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, May 3, 2023 Plitvice Lakes - Opatija Travel among the park’s dense forests and 16 terraced lakes, where waterfalls and free-flowing cascades connect one lake to the other. forest landscapes of Plitvice Lakes, travel this afternoon to the seaside resort of Opatija, known as “Croatia’s Riviera.” This fashionable region was once the summer retreat for Roman Caesars and Habsburg Monarchs. Get acquainted with this coastal town on a brief walking tour. Enjoy an evening at leisure. (B)

Day 8: Thursday, May 4, 2023 Opatija - Istrian Peninsula - Opatija Discover the richness of the Istrian Peninsula with its Italian and Croatian influences. Pay a visit to a local distillery, where the owners use regional plants, fruits, and herbs to produce brandies, snacks and other treats. Discover a picture-perfect example of a rural Croatian town. In the late afternoon, a delightful farm-to-table dinner at a local restaurant lets you sample the regional wines and culinary delicacies of the Istrian Peninsula. (B, D)

Day 9: Friday, May 5, 2023 Opatija - Ljubljana, Slovenia Travel into picturesque Slovenia, arriving in Ljubljana, a capital city in the midst of a cultural renaissance. 

Trogir is set on a small island but is connected to the main land by bridge. Located within medieval walls, admire the prominent stone houses and scenic charm as you tour this historic city with a local guide. Visit the 13th-century Cathedral of St. Lawrence and admire the sweeping views from its bell tower. Enjoy free time to discover the city’s hidden nooks and crannies. Day 3: Sarajevo

Discover Sarajevo with an expert guide, spending time in its beautiful city hall. The city center is home to a wide variety of religions, all living in harmony. As you make your way along the storied roadways, admire the significant blend of architectural styles, featuring facades of Gothic, Ottoman, and Romanesque origins. In the evening, a local guide takes you on an orientation tour of Old Town Budva where you'll uncover winding alleyways, sandy beaches, and stone bastions. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 6: Budva

The day is yours to take in even more of Montenegro's coral-colored beaches, sun-soaked squares and crumbling castles. Perhaps you'll spend your day cruising around the Bay of Kotor, a small but scenic cerulean cove known for its breathtaking beauty. Or, maybe you'll venture to Lovcen, a mountain and national park in Montenegro blanketed by craggy peaks, lush valleys and rambling trails. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 7: Budva – Dubrovnik, Croatia

Make your way from Montenegro to Dubrovnik to begin your journey through Croatia and the intriguing countries of the Adriatic. *Today breakfast will be included.*

During your extension, your local guide will provide included sightseeing services.
