The exhibition tells the story of Sherald’s vision and practice through approximately 40 paintings created from 2007 to the present. In 2016, Sherald made history as the first African American to win the grand prize in the National Portrait Gallery’s Outwin Boochever Portrait Competition for her painting *Miss Everything (Unsuppressed Deliverance)*. That recognition led to the commission of the official portrait of former First Lady Michelle Obama for the National Portrait Gallery’s collection.
